As temperatures drop, Good Neighbors GTX is once again rallying the Berry Creek community for its annual coat drive, asking for new coats in sizes 4T to XL. Last year, the nonprofit provided over 300 children with warm outerwear and with community support, they hope to help even more this season.

Good Neighbors GTX is a local nonprofit dedicated to serving children and teens from low-income and crisis-stricken families here in Georgetown. Rooted in the message of "Love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:39), the organization offers essential clothing and living items free of charge with no questions asked.

This year, their reach has expanded even further. From assisting families affected by floods to supporting single mothers starting from scratch, the group has stepped in as one of the first responders when crisis strikes. One growing area of need has been for new moms who need assistance with the necessities of raising a baby. GNGTX steps in providing many

baby care needs including car seats to ensure these babies can leave the hospital safely and legally.

"Berry Creek was very generous last year and we are grateful," says Berry Creek resident and Good Neighbors GTX team member Becky Scogin. A donation box will be located in the lobby area at The Club at Berry Creek from September 2nd through October 6th.
